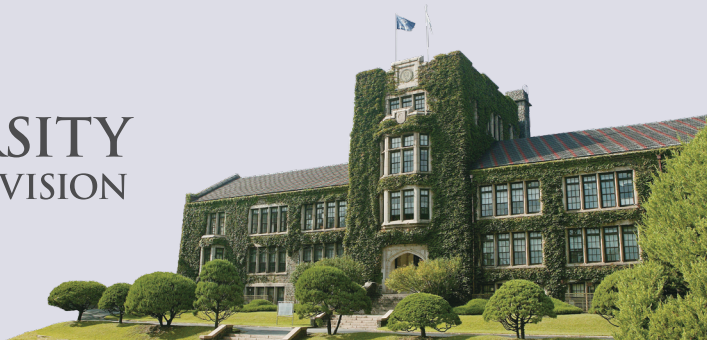

- International Education Program based upon Cultural Diversity & Intercultural Communication
- For students who need to improve their communication skills, GLD provides college Korean courses
- International students and overseas Korean students who have completed 12 years of education outside Korea can enroll either in March or in September

GLD Community

- Total number of Students **586**
- Koreans Students educated abroad **342**
- International Students **244**
- * GLD students have come from more than 26 countries including Korea, China, Japan, USA, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Thailand, Malaysia, Vietnam, Brazil, Turkmenistan, New Zealand and etc.

Qualifications

High School Graduation Requirements : Applicants must graduate from high school before the 1st day of school

▶ International Students

Nationality Requirements : Applicants and both their parents should have a non-Korean nationality

* If a student or either one of the student's parents has a dual citizenship with Korea, the student is not eligible for this track

▶ Overseas Korean Students

Qualification requirements : Students who have completed all of the 12 years of pre-university education overseas or that of the equivalence

GLD Education model for International Students

Academic Korean Supporting Program

▶ Basic Korean (TOPIK Level 1, 2)

▪ Contents

Strengthen communicational skills and increase learning initiative regarding academic Korean

▪ Supporting System

Additional study with a TA(graduate student) and personal mentor(native GLD student)

▶ Academic Korean (TOPIK Level 3, 4)

▪ Contents

Execute education in Korean to assist in comprehending topic-centered academic material related to one's major (academic vocabulary, basic academic terms, reading academic text)

▪ Supporting System

Matching system with a native speaker of the student's country upperclassman, and elective classes that help in understanding the society and history of Korea

Academic Program for helping General Courses (TOPIK LEVEL 5, 6)

▪ Contents

'Sheltered content instruction' considering learner's background of education

▪ Supporting System

Individual Assistant by TA(subject helper) or Peer Mentor(senior)

Supporting Program for Major Studies (TOPIK LEVEL 5, 6)

▪ Contents

Provide professors who teach flexibly based on the students' level of Korean to help them learn intensified major subjects

▪ Supporting System

Advanced studying with the TA(1 hour) along with the provision of the video recording of the class, personal guidance of TA/mentor to student through Office Hour

Majors

International Commerce

International Commerce major focuses on the study of global politics, business, economics, cooperation and further discussion and research through the basis of understanding Korean Society

→ Career Fields : Multinational Corporations, Public Enterprise related to International Development and Cooperation(KOTRA, KOICA), Micro & Financial Economics related with Statistics, International Commerce & Negotiation, Global Business
