## **Tenure-Track Position Announcement**

The College of Business at Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate Professor position in the field of Information Systems. The appointment will commence in either February or September 2019. The requirements for this position are as follows: (a) Ph.D. degree in information systems, statistics, industrial engineering or related fields; (b) an established publication record in toptier academic journals commensurate with experience; and (c) evidence of teaching effectiveness. The candidate must have completed a doctorate before the date of appointment and show evidence of outstanding potential for research. Applicants for the rank of Associate Professor should have an outstanding record of research productivity. KAIST College of Business is a graduate-only program, and the successful candidate will be expected to teach graduate-level courses. For new faculty members, the typical teaching load is one course per semester, and each new member will have his or her own research lab. While we will consider candidates with a wide range of interests, the ideal candidate would have an interest in teaching and conducting research in the quantitative and technical areas, including, but not limited to, statistics, business analytics, artificial intelligence & machine learning, economics of IS, and data programming.
